

## Kindergarten

Students must be five years old by September 30<sup>th</sup> in order to start kindergarten. Currently Peak to Peak offers one full-day and two half-day kindergarten classes. Our kindergarten class times are:

Morning Half-Day: 8:00 AM-11:10 AM

Afternoon Half-Day PM: 11:50 AM-3:00 PM

Full Day: 8:00 AM-3:00 PM

The full-day kindergarten class is available for a monthly fee and includes a weekly swimming lesson. Our kindergarten curriculum includes appropriate placement in math and language arts, science, social studies, physical education, art, music and library. The classroom time includes a lot of focus and activities related to character development. Kindergarten students also participate in the school reading buddies program.
