In high demand:

- Feminine hygiene products:** pads, tampons
- Cooking oils:** canola & olive
- Baby items:** baby food, formula, size 5 diapers
- Pet items:** dog food, cat food, cat litter, treats
- Canned Tomatoes:** diced
- COVID items:** disposable gloves, face masks, cleaning wipes

In moderate demand:

- Fruit:** canned (low or no sugar), applesauce

- Protein:** canned chicken, pinto beans, white beans
- Canned soups & stews, chicken bouillon**
 - Nut Butters:** peanut, almond, soy, etc.
 - Grains:** rice, flour, gluten-free items, pastas
 - Canned Tomatoes:** diced, whole, paste, stewed, spaghetti sauce
- Toiletries:** shampoo, conditioner, toilet paper, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.
