Through collaboration, the library media center faculty partner with the larger Peak to Peak community to empower students in becoming lifetime learners, responsible citizens, and industrious problem solvers.

The Peak to Peak Library Media Center's curriculum supports the **Standards for the 21st Century Learner**. Specifically, information literacy learners use skills, resources, and tools to:

- Inquire, think critically and gain knowledge
- Draw conclusions, make informed decisions, apply knowledge to new situations, and create new knowledge.
- Share knowledge and participate ethically and productively as members of our democratic society
- Pursue personal and aesthetic growth.

All classes have access to fiction and non-fiction materials. Library lessons also include lessons on website evaluation, citation, and using databases for research. K-5 classes compare and contrast fiction and nonfiction books with emphasis on understanding the parts of a nonfiction book (Table of Contents, Glossary, Index, Labeling, and Graphs/ Charts). K-5 students learn how to find books using Destiny, the library's search engine. Third graders also have keyboard instruction the second half of the school year (Type to Learn).
